- 4. Why is Stephen's speech significant in the development of the plot of Acts?

SECTION B

Answer any two questions. (30 minutes per question)

- 5. How does Revelation encourage persecuted churches?
- 6. In 1 & 2 Thessalonians, why does Paul go into so much detail about the parousia?
- 7. What is Paul's purpose in his depiction of Jesus' Lordship in Colossians 1:15–23?
- 8. Is it likely that the book of Hebrews was written to Christians in Jerusalem during the persecutions of Nero?
