1. Explain the significance of the concept of 'Holiness' in Leviticus.
2. Does the book of Deuteronomy have a coherent message? Give reasons for your answer.

**Make sure you have answered just ONE of the above questions.**

3. What is the function of the Othniel narrative in the book of Judges?
4. What is the view of Kingship presented in the books of Samuel?
5. How does the material on David and Jonathan contribute to the message of the books of Samuel?
6. What is the significance and message of 1 Kings 8?
7. What function does Naaman play in the narrative of 2 Kings?

**Section B** (66.6% of Exam Paper)

*Students must answer 2 questions.*

*Spend 80 minutes on Section B – about 40 minutes on each of your two answers.*

1. Does the Pentateuch teach a 'gospel of grace'?
  2. Is the book of Joshua optimistic or pessimistic?
  3. Is it justified to describe Joshua-2 Kings as 'Deuteronomic'?
  4. How important is Saul to the books of 1 & 2 Samuel?
  5. Are there any good kings in the books of Kings? Give reasons for your answer.
