4. 'The book of Nehemiah is a great handbook for Christian leadership'  
Discuss.
5. Do the narrative sections and apocalyptic sections of Daniel present the same message?
6. Why do you think the book of Chronicles was written?
7. Why are the Twelve (the so-called 'minor prophets') important?
8. Do you think it's possible to talk about the 'theology of the Prophets' (i.e. the books Isaiah-Malachi in English Versions) If so, what might that look like? If not, justify your conviction.
